Actions Arising	499	AC to forward documentation to NatWest to confirm his signature on the Bank Signing Mandate. A statement from the Electric Vehicle Steering Group has been sent to the Hungarton News for publication. JM to publish under Parish Council Heading. The Environmental Sub-Committee will now not meet until the New Year. AC to chase Jo Peryer for an agenda. Manor Farm: AC to review new material from the applicant and draft a response to share with councillors and submit. CP to review Harborough DC's response to Neighbourhood Plan modifications for discussion at January meeting.
Planning Applications	500	20/01893/FUL – Hope Farm Main Street. CP declared an interest in this application given her close proximity. This was noted by the PC but not felt to be material. The application was fully discussed and a draft response will be shared with councillors and when agreed submitted to HDC. The PC determined that it was the applicants' responsibility to advertise and allocate the subsidised home. AC to communicate this to the applicants.
Commemorative Bench	501	The PC considered the question of a bench in memory of Roger Rowland. JM offered to talk to Roger's family, via Kate Richmond, to get their views on the matter. Once a better understanding of the location and cost of this was established, the PC would decide in what way best to offer their assistance with this project.


